The time has come for high school course selection!

Oregon High School will hold an informational meeting for eighth grade students and parents on Thursday, February 1st from 7:30-8:30 pm in the Oregon High School gym at the Jefferson Street entrance. Please plan to arrive at 7:15 pm to allow enough time to pick up materials and find a seat in the gym. A presentation by the Oregon High School counselors will begin at 7:30 pm.
