

Student Meal Accounts

The Food Service Department of OCUSD recognizes the parent/guardian responsibility to provide a lunch for their children by assuring funds are available in their students lunch account or by providing a lunch from home.

Meals Payments

The District uses a pre - paid system for school meals and has a no charge policy. Funds must be deposited into a student's account prior to meal/milk/ala carte purchase.

Deposits may be made at all District School Offices.

Meals payments may also be made using eFunds our online payment system.

K– 6 Breakfast/Lunch Money is collected by teachers in the class room and taken to the office for deposit.

7 - 8 Grade - Lunch money is collected in the DLR Jr. High Office

9 - 12 Grade - Lunch money is turned in by students in the OHS office or checks only can be placed in the drop box located outside the school office.

To ensure proper credit for deposits please place deposit in an envelope with the *students full name, school, and deposit amount* written on the outside of the envelope.

You may deposit for all students in your family at one school; be sure to write all students school and the amount for each student on the envelope. Funds received after 10:00am will be credited to the next day.

E-Funds: Payments for student meal accounts may be made online through a service called e-funds. By going to the school district's website, www.ocusd.net and selecting make/view lunch payments, you may make food service payments for all your students with a credit card or a bank account transfer.

* If you are new to the system you will need your students ID number. It may be obtained by calling the Food Service Director at 815-732-2186 EXT 1008.

How does e-Funds for Schools work?

Families set up and maintain their own log ins, passwords, and payment preferences. Your account information is retained in a password-protected file.

e-Funds will help to eliminate last minute check writing hassles, improve efficiencies, and help cut costs for both you and the school district

On-line payments will help eliminate the worry that your children could lose or forget the money intended for school items or that it might be spent on other non-school related items.

Payments from a debit/credit card or checking account may easily be set up. Parents/guardians may establish a reoccurring payment or may opt to make a one-time payment, and set up low balance notices.

Parents may view student balances and transaction history at any time. Please be aware that the system updates overnight, so recent purchases may not show until the following day.
