 - Adam explained Standard Error Measurements and Confidence Intervals
 - Given the current data, only one Special Education teacher would have been proficient. We will use this to aid in our development of the evaluation tool.
 - Is IQ Factored in? --no, we really can't do that.
 - Principal and teacher should be setting growth target
