1. Questions about SLOs

- How many do teachers need that have more than one prep? Do they need two for each prep?
 - At least 2 SLOs covering 50% of what they teach
 - At least 2/3 SLOs covering 50% of what they teach.
 - SLOs should have been discussed with building principals and approved??? There was some question about this.

2. Assessments and Types

- If there is a Type I or Type II available for your class, then you have to use it.
- Discussion of how to write a pretest that isn't too hard to show obvious given growth for every single student.
 - Maybe testing concepts more than specifics. Questions like "What do you know about _____?"
 - For instance, in Spanish I, students know no vocabulary
- Perhaps someone representing the RCD team can remind teachers of what a good assessment looks like.
- Kim and Ranae will look in the blue and white assessment training books we received from Kara

3. Looking through rest of OCUSD 220 PERA Plan Packet:

- Turn evaluation points and levels into a more user-friendly matrix (Page 2 after cover page)
- Update (Page 3) with grade levels/positions and assessment types
- Perhaps make page 3 into an exhibit, not necessarily part of the packet as it will be a working document based on yearly positions.

4. Once we hammer out this documents, it will go to the OEA Evaluation Committee for review
